## World Animal Day celebrated

To raise awareness of sufferings in working animals and recognising their services, the Brooke in collaboration with Richmond Crawford Veterinary Hospital, Karachi, organized two events to celebrate World animal Day 2008 on Thursday.

The Brooke (Pakistan) is an animal welfare organisation, which primarily works with working animals and their owners by providing free treatment and empowering people in preventative husbandry services. It is currently operating in 12 districts of Pakistan.

Participants of the events included Theosophical Order of Services, Karachi Chief Executive Admiral (retd) M I Arshad, Sindh Government Livestock and Fisheries Department Director General Dr Ghular Sarwar, Pakistan Animal Welfare Society, Karachi representative Maheen Zia, Richmond Crawford Veterinary Hospital, Karachi Incharge Veterinary Officer Dr Abdul Wahab Bhutto, representatives of equine owners, Dr Asim Anwar, Dr Reza Ahmad, Muneeza Sadiq, Dr Sher Nawaz and Dr Naimatullah Somroo from The Brooke Pakistan.

Sarwar emphasised the importance of equine welfare, and assured participants that his department will continue cooperating with the Brooke for long term poverty alleviation of poor equine owning communities. Zia highlighted the need to work for the better welfare of all animals including equines. She stressed the importance of working simultaneously on environmental issues and better animal welfare, as the two are interrelated issues.

Admiral (retd) M I Arshad appreciated the work being done by The Brooke for equine welfare and sustainable livelihoods of the poor equine owners.

He appreciated the continuous endeavours of the Richmond Crawford Veterinary Hospital to make the lives of animals free from suffering and disease. He assured that Theosophical Order of Services will continue supporting the efforts of the Brooke.

Lastly, the equine owners reiterated their desire to give best possible treatments to their equines, as donkeys, horses and mules have been their loyal and long standing partners. Participants later took part in a walk to show solidarity with the cause of Brooke, Pakistan.
